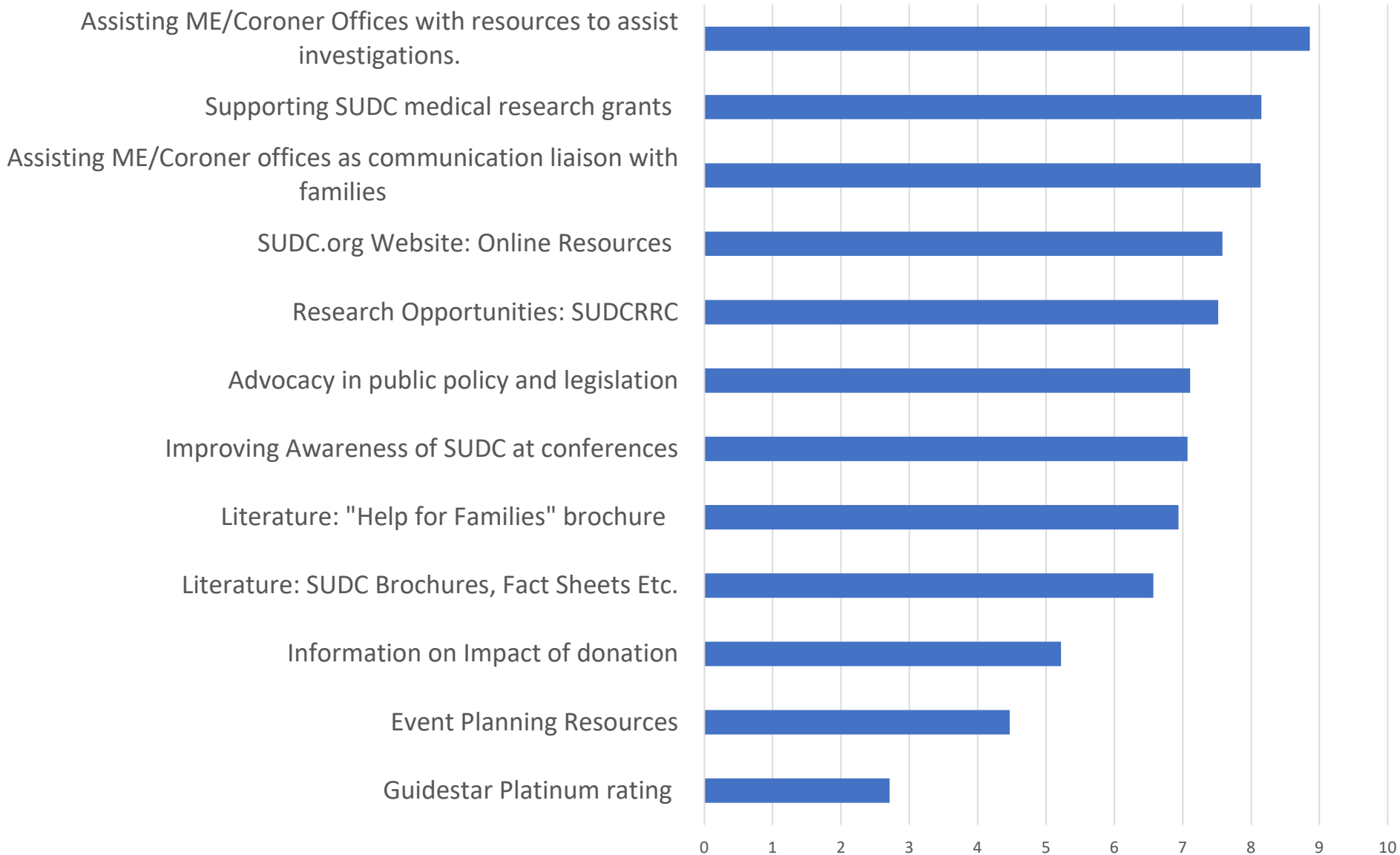
We asked our stakeholders to rank our direct family services and our community services. The results are helping us to strategically drive resources for the best impact for our community.

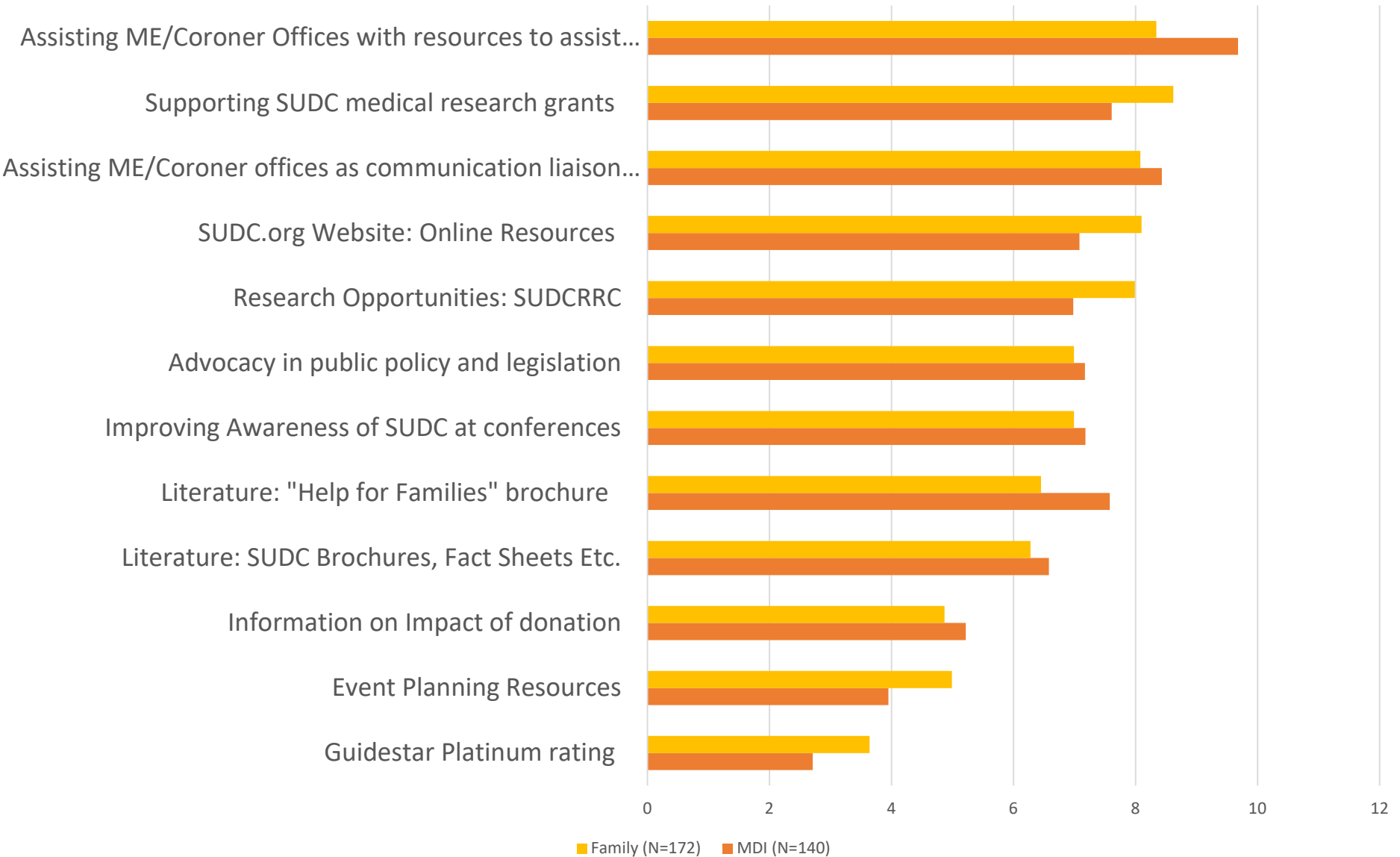

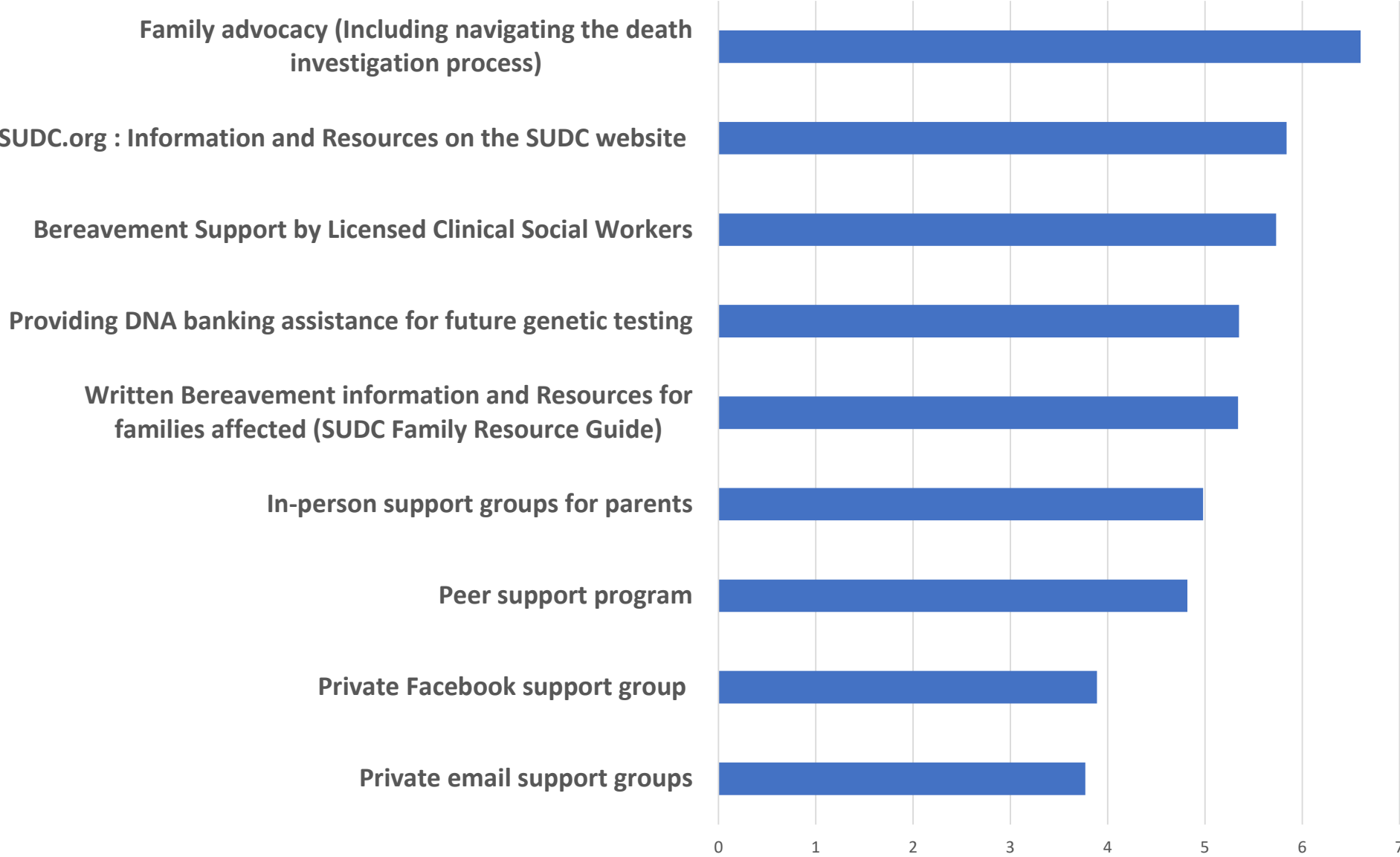
What are the Most Important SUDC Foundation Community Services to SUDC Stakeholders? (N=336)



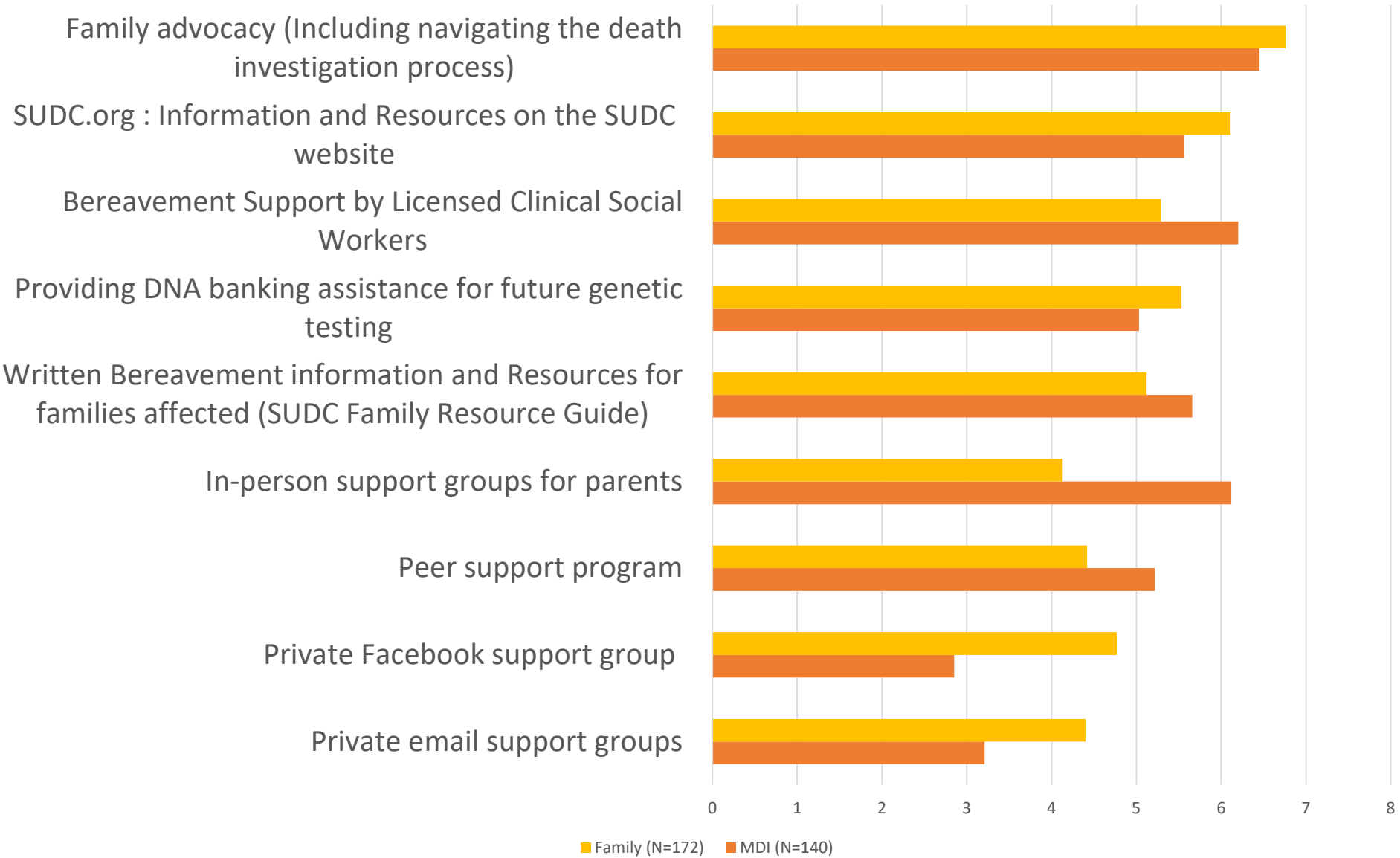
What are the most important SUDC Foundation community services to ME/C Professionals and SUDC Families?
